WHO IS A LEGAL REGISTERED INDIVIDUAL (LRI)?

LRI is anyone who is a parent, legal guardian, or spouse of legal guardian.


It has been approved by CMS to be July 1, 2024. Families should contact their care manager for more information. Agencies should tell families to contact their care managers

WHEN CAN A WAIVER RECIPIENT WHO IS RECEIVING SUPPORT FROM A SPOUSE START RECEIVING THE STRUCTURED FAMILY CAREGIVING SERVICE ON THE HEALTH AND WELLNESS, PATHWAYS, AND TRAUMATIC BRAIN INJURY WAIVERS?

Wavier recipients whose spouse will provide Structured Family Caregiving can work with their care manager at anytime to consider including this service in their service plan








Question 3

HOW DO I FIGURE OUT WHAT LEVEL OF STRUCTURED FAMILY CARE THE WAIVER RECIPIENT RECEIVES?

For individuals who are 18 years or older, the care manager will decide on the level depending on the individual's needs. Individuals under 18 years-old will be given a level of SFC. From now until July 1, 2024, the SFC levels will be based on the hours of attended care since May 1. 2024.

FAMILY CAREGIVERS RECIEVING COMPENSATION



CAN A FAMILY CAREGIVER RECEIVE COMPENSATION FOR PROVIDING STRUCTURED FAMILY CAREGIVING WHILE THE INDIVIDUAL UNDER THEIR CARE IS ALSO RECEIVING ADDITIONAL WAIVER SERVICES ON THE SAME DAY?

Yes, a member can assist in other Medicaid services or waivers along with SFC, unless they duplicate what's already provided by the SFC. We encourage members to explore more services to complement their existing SFC benefits.






WHAT SFC AND UNSKILLED RESPITE ENTAIL

DOES SFC INCLUDE RESPITE?

a. Consider Respite as a temporary support system that offers caregivers reprieve while ensuring the ongoing needs of the members are taken care of during this break.

b. Non-specialized Respite is a part of the comprehensive framework of Structured Family Caregiving.

c. The SFC service accommodates up to 15 days of non-specialized respite care annually. It is imperative for the member and their caregiver to liaise with their preferred SFC provider to leverage this respite care. From July 1 onwards, it becomes the responsibility of SFC providers to manage and deliver the nonspecialized respite care included in this service.



WHAT DOES UNSKILLED RESPITE CARE ENTAIL?

Unskilled respite care refers to services that are intermittently delivered in place of the usual caregiver. These services, which aid the recipient in performing daily life activities, need not be provided by licensed professionals. They could be offered by a direct service worker, who might be a family member, friend, or even a neighbor. Your SFC provider agency could employ or contract these workers. This type of respite can happen in a home or community-based environment
